## INTERMEDIATE CERTIFICATE

### **Programme choice**

- At least one song **must** be performed from Group A (Opera, Operetta, Sacred, Oratorio, Popular, Musical Theatre or Film).
- Please refer to the current <u>Music Certificates syllabus</u> for further guidelines, including inclusion of Grade 5 repertoire and own-choice songs.

### **Memory**

• Any or all songs may be performed from memory, which may improve note security and confidence. Although this is not compulsory and no additional marks are given for this, over-reliance on the score may inhibit communication and this can be reflected in the marks awarded.

## **Keys**

- All songs may be performed by any voice type and in any key, published or transposed.
- Songs that are indicated as (F) or (M) have been identified as being more suitable for either female or male voices. However, this information is provided as guidance only, and candidates may choose to ignore it. Candidates may change pronouns and other gender-specific wording as appropriate.

## Language

- All songs must be performed in the original language. (In cases where a work is by tradition performed in a variety of languages, eg Haydn's Creation/Schöpfung, any of the customary languages will be acceptable.)
- At least **two** living languages (ie not Latin) must be used, one of which may be English.
