

Trinity's **GESE** | Graded Examinations in Spoken English

What is GESE?

Trinity's GESE exams are one-to-one assessments of speaking and listening skills, available at 12 graded levels from Pre-A1 to C2, aligned with the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). Suitable for all ages and abilities, GESE supports learners' progression from beginner to advanced.

Why choose GESE?

- ▶ **Motivational:** Achievable steps inspire learners to progress.
- ▶ **Personalised:** Candidates prepare their own topic for interactive discussion at Grades 4-12.
- ▶ **Expert examiners:** Supportive examiners encourage candidates to perform at their best.

Learning progression


As learners move through the grades, they demonstrate:

Initial	1-3	Pre-A1 to A2	5-7 mins	Conversation
Elementary	4-6	A2+ to B1+	10 mins	Conversation, Topic discussion
Intermediate	7-9	B2 to B2++	15 mins	Conversation, Topic discussion, interactive task
Advanced	10-12	C1 to C2	25 mins	Conversation, Topic discussion, interactive task, Listening task, Topic presentation
