Method of delivery

The format for Step 1 and Step 2 exams is a one-to-one conversation with a Trinity examiner. Assessments are held face-to-face at registered exam centres. They can be taken on demand and are available at the same time, and alongside Trinity's face-to-face ESOL Skills for Life exams.

Minimum fees

ESOL Step 1 and Step 2 exams are charged as above and each session is subject to a minimum fee of 750.00 (GBP).

Multiple levels

You can book multiple levels in an ESOL Skills for Life/ESOL Step 1 and Step 2 examination session.

Regulatory

Trinity's ESOL Step 1 and Step 2 awards are Trinity-certified pre-Entry level preliminary qualifications and are not regulated by Ofqual.

Speaking & Listening: There are no minimum fees for the Speaking & Listening module of ESOL Skills for Life when delivered online. Face-to-face sessions are subject to a minimum fee of 750.00 (GBP).

Minimum & Joint Fees

Speaking & Listening: There are no minimum fees for the Speaking & Listening module of ISE when delivered online. Face-to-face sessions are subject to a minimum fee of 1063.00 (GBP).

Reading & Writing: ISE Reading & Writing exam bookings are charged as above and each session is subject to a minimum fee of 369.00 (GBP).

There are no minimum fees for ISE Digital.

To receive the 'Joint Fee', learners must be enrolled for both modules of the ISE exam at the same time.

Approved for British Citizenship, Settlement and visa applications

Secure English Language Tests (SELTs) are used to prove a person's English language proficiency and are required when applying for British Citizenship, Settlement, or a visa for work or study in the United Kingdom.

Communication Skills by online delivery

Individual candidates are now able to take their communication skills assessments online via video conferencing in registered exam centres. Groups can only take assessments face-to-face in registered exam centres.

Minimum fees

Online: Bookings for Communication Skills by online delivery are subject to a minimum fee of 354.00 (GBP).

Face-to-face: Bookings for Communication Skills delivered face-to-face are subject to a minimum fee of 683.00 (GBP).

Groups

For ensembles of three or more candidates, the 'individual face-to-face' fee listed above for that particular grade is payable for the groups as a whole, plus an additional group surcharge fee of 15.00 (GBP) will be added per candidate within that group.
