Recognised by the British Council and offered by over 150 Trinity-approved course providers globally, the CertTESOL opens doors for teaching opportunities worldwide.

Key Features

Flexible delivery: Available full-time, part-time, online, face-to-face or as a blended course (varies by provider).

Comprehensive training: 200 hours total (130 hours of guided learning, 70 hours of self-study).

Essential TESOL knowledge and skills: Courses cover a comprehensive introduction to contemporary theory and practical application in the classroom.

Practical teaching experience: Six hours of observed teaching practice with real learners.

CertTESOL Units Overview:

- Unit 1: Teaching skills Develops practical classroom skills through observations of experienced teachers and teaching practice, feedback and reflection, providing hands-on teaching experience.
- Unit 2: Language awareness & skills Builds understanding of lexis, grammar, phonology and discourse, with an emphasis on language assessment and varieties of English.
- Unit 3: The Learner profile Focuses on oneto-one teaching, diagnosing a real learner's needs and tailoring lessons to support individual learning goals.

Entrants for CertTESOL courses must have qualifications and/or experience that would allow entrance to higher education, with minimum English language proficiency

- Unit 4: The materials assignment Enhances skills in selecting, adapting, creating and evaluating classroom materials for effective teaching.
- Unit 5: The unknown language Provides insight into the learner's perspective by simulating the experience of learning a new language, fostering empathy and teaching insight.
