

Trinity SELT Centre Belfast

Forsyth House (Regus) Cromac Square Belfast BT2 8LA



Forsyth House is a modern, red brick and glass building situated at the junction of Cromac and East Bridge Streets. The building houses several organisations and is not signed as Trinity College London. Upon arrival, press the buzzer located on the left side of the door and report to reception.

Accessibility

The building is fully accessible.

Getting there



By train

Exit Central Station onto East Bridge Street. Walk left down East Bridge Street, past St George's Market (on the right-hand side). Forsyth House is at the corner of the junction between East Bridge Street and Cromac Street.



By bus

Take bus 1, 2, 5, 7, 9 or 10 and get off at St George's Market. Continue to walk along May Street and turn left onto Cromac Street. Forsyth House is at the corner of the junction between East Bridge Street and Cromac Street.



By car

Forsyth House is accessible via the M1, M3 and A20. Follow signs for Belfast city centre.



Parking

Trinity College London has no parking facilities. However, nearby car park facilities are:

- Cromac Street Car Park
 Cromac Street, Belfast BT2 8JN
 (entrance on Eliza Street).
 Forsyth House is directly opposite the car
 park at the East Bridge Street exit.
- Victoria Square Shopping Centre
 1 Victoria Street, Belfast BT1 4QG
 (entrance on Victoria Street).
 Exit onto Victoria Street, cross the road
 and turn right. Follow Victoria Street as it
 becomes Cromac Street. Forsyth House is
 at the corner of the junction between East
 Bridge Street and Cromac Street.
