1 Victoria Square is a large office building situated on the corner of Hill Street and New Street. It is in the bottom left corner of Victoria Square opposite Birmingham Town Hall. The building is marked with a large red number 1 to indicate its address and has a large glass entrance to the main reception. A member of staff will greet you in reception and take you up to our centre which is located on the 7th floor.

If you are arriving by car, please allow extra time for roadworks and parking in the city centre. Trinity College London has no parking facilities and you will need to park and then walk to the centre. Additionally, the Birmingham Clean Air Zone operates 24 hours a day, 365 days a year and charges will be applied daily.

Accessibility

Step-free access and lifts inside to enable easy access to the centre.

Getting there



By train

Birmingham New Street Station

- Take the Navigation Street exit from Birmingham New Street Station.
- Turn left onto Navigation Street and walk until you reach a large crossroad junction (just before Sainsbury's).
- When you reach the large junction, turn right onto Hill Street.
- Continue up Hill Street until you reach Victoria Square. The Trinity building is directly on your left, just in front of the tram stop.

Moor Street Station

- Exit the station and cross directly over the road towards the Primark shop.
- Walk up the steps and slope towards the Bullring Shopping Centre. You will come out directly opposite Zara women's clothes shop.
- Turn slightly to the right to join a large pedestrianised road called New Street.
- Continue on New Street until you reach Victoria Square.
- Cross over the tram tracks until you are in the far corner of Victoria Square. The Trinity building is on the left, on the corner of Hill Street.



By tram

You can take the tram directly to the centre. Get off at the Town Hall tram stop and the Trinity building is directly behind the stop.



By bus

- Take bus number 9, X10, X7, 10, 10H, 82, 87, 13, 12, 12A or X8 and get off at Colmore Row.
- With the church and park on your left, continue straight on Colmore Row until you reach Victoria Square (with Starbucks coffee shop on your right).
- Continue with the Council House on your right towards the statue of Queen Victoria.
- Continue past the statue of Queen Victoria. The Trinity building will be directly in front of you, with a big red number 1 at the front.



By ca

Take the M5, M6 (North Birmingham), M40, M42, or M6 Toll, following signs for Birmingham city centre.



Parking

Trinity College London has no parking facilities. However, nearby car park facilities are:

- NCP Car Park Birmingham Grand Central (entrance on Hill Street B5 4DQ)
- NCP Car Park Navigation Street (entrance on Navigation Street B5 4AD)
