Temple Court is a beautifully converted synagogue located close to the city centre. A staff member will meet candidates at reception on the ground floor and escort them upstairs. The Trinity SELT centre is on the 2nd floor.

Getting there



By train

Cardiff Central Station

- Exit Cardiff Central Station onto Central Square. Turn left on Central Square and walk to the end of the road. Turn left into Wood Street and cross over the road and walk down onto Millennium Walk (next to the river). Continue along Millennium walk until you reach Cardiff Bridge. Turn left and walk over the bridge until Cathedral Road. Turn right into Cathedral Road and the centre is down the road on the left-hand side. It takes approximately 15-20 minutes to walk. Taxis are available directly outside the building at Cardiff Central Station.



By bus

National Express Cardiff Coach Station. Exit the coach station and turn right. Walk down the road until you reach a roundabout. At the roundabout turn left onto Sophia Close. Walk down Sophia Close until you reach Cathedral Road. Turn left onto Cathedral Road and the centre is down the road on the right-hand side.

- Local bus services that stop near Temple Court are 122,24,62,63 and X1.



By car
