

## Trinity SELT Centre Preston

The Recycling Lives Building is a modern, glass-fronted building situated at the junction of Kent and Essex Streets. The building houses several organisations and is not signed as Trinity College London. Upon arriving, a member of Trinity College London staff will meet you and escort you to the centre.

## Getting there



### By train

- Exit the train station and turn right onto Fishergate and then almost immediately turn left onto Corporation Street. At the bottom of Corporation Street, turn right and proceed along A59. At the end of the A59, turn left onto A6. Turn right and walk along Great George Street, then turn left onto Kent Street. Recycling Lives building is at the corner of Kent Street and Essex Street.



### By car

- Trinity SELT Preston is accessible via the M6, A6, A59 and A583. Follow signs for Preston city centre.



### Parking

- Trinity College London offers no parking facilities except on Saturdays and Sundays only when candidates can use the building car park.



### By bus

- Take bus 14, 40, 41 or 45 and get off at Great George Street.
- Walk along Great George Street, then turn left onto Kent Street. Recycling Lives building is at the corner of Kent Street and Essex Street.
